- Led a crew as a floor hand on workover rigs doing acid jobs, fishing jobs, swab jobs, well cleanouts, plug and abandonment, and gas lift mandrel insertions across the Eagle Ford Basin.
- Operated and maintained roughly \$33,500 of equipment such as hydraulic tongs, tubing elevators, and rod elevators. I also learned the basics of operating the rig itself, tallied pipe, ran the forklift and aerial manlift.
- Solved production problems with wells that were unable to hold pressure due to faulty tubing, collars, and breaks in casing. One well in particular saw a 4.6% increase in production.
- Tested and repaired faulty blow out preventers, also built blowout preventers for pulling rods out of the hole.
- Fixed transmissions on broken rigs and company trucks for two consecutive weeks. Worked closely with the company mechanics on a full transmission replacement for a Taylor rig saving the company over \$3,500.
